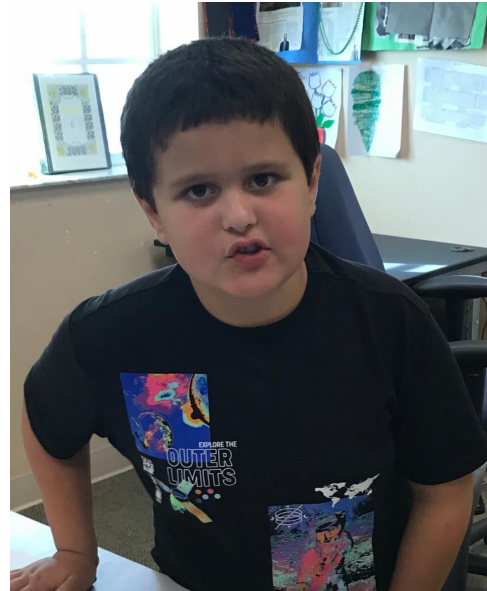
Spotlight on Success ADT
